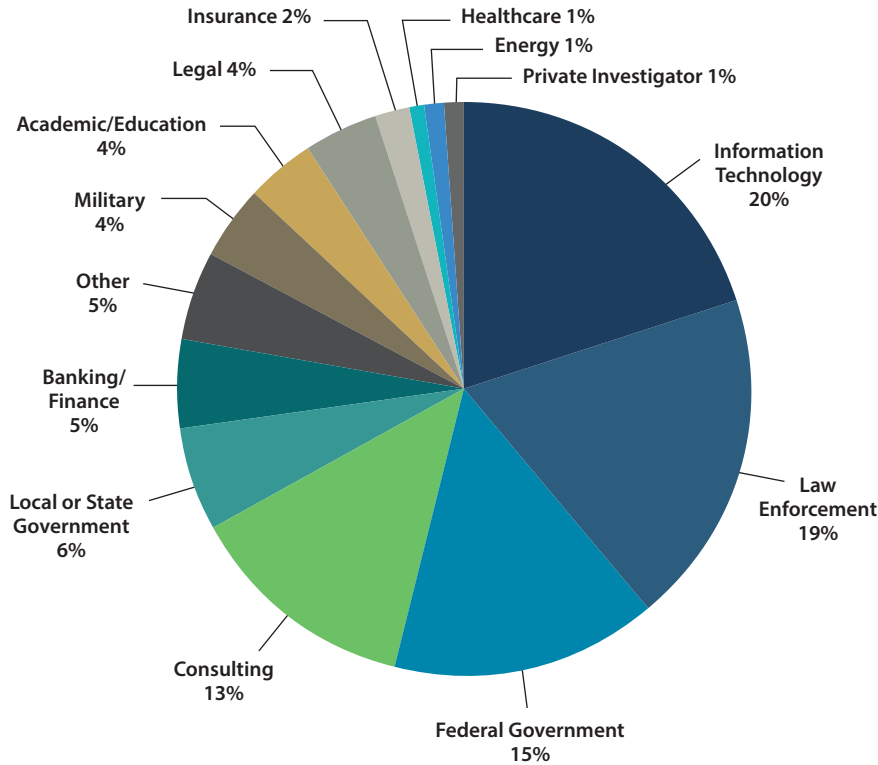

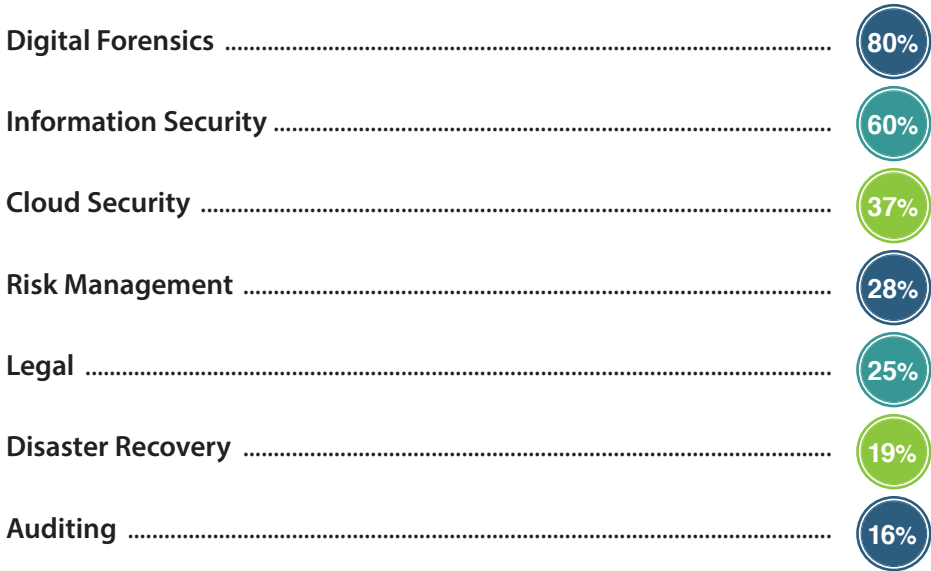
Attendee Industry Classifications

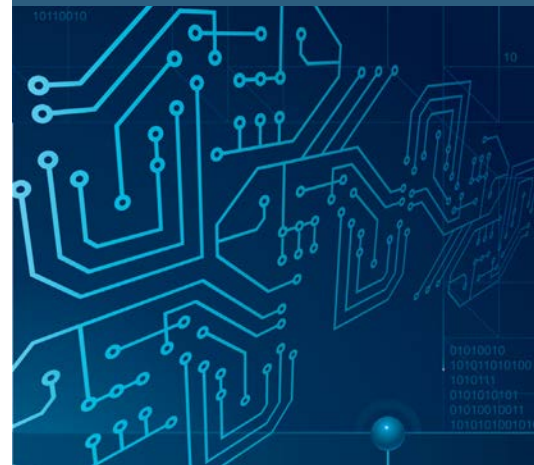

- More than forty Cybersecurity firms are headquartered in San Antonio and it is one of the largest concentrations of IT, Information Assurance (IA) and cybersecurity professionals in the nation. ***
- San Antonio has the #2 concentration of data centers in the U.S., and 80-plus companies specializing in defense technology.***

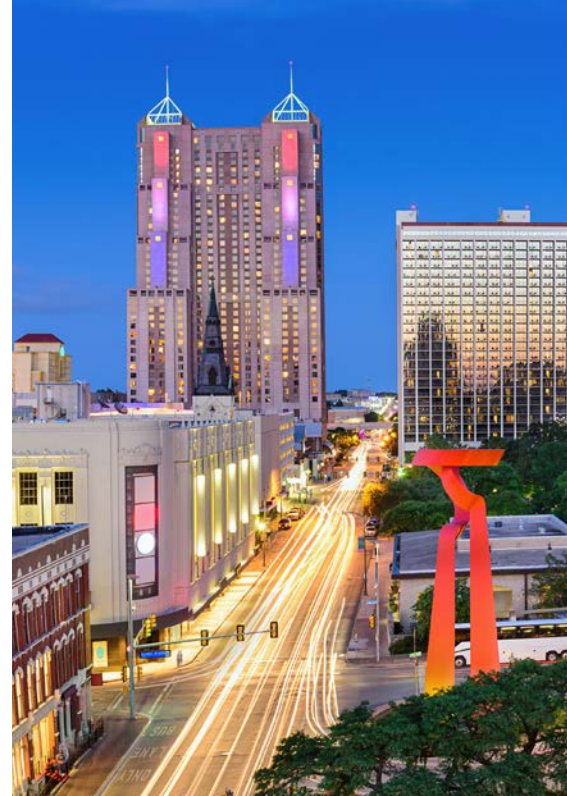
